## A RESOLUTION

To designate Wednesday, April 30, 2025, as Delta Sigma Theta Incorporated Day at the state capitol.

WHEREAS, the members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated, stand on the shoulders of giants such as former state representatives Renee Gill Pratt, Rosalind Peychaud, Jalila Jefferson Bullock, and the late Pinkie Carolyn Wilkerson, and former state senators Diana E. Bajoie, Karen Carter Peterson, and Cheryl Gray Evans who have left an incredible imprint on this state's history; and

WHEREAS, membership in this highly regarded, service-based sorority also includes our very own Secretary of the Senate Yolanda J. Dixon; and

WHEREAS, to uplift, encourage, and develop the global community, the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated, focuses its efforts on the Five-Point Programmatic Thrust of: Economic Development; Educational Development; International Awareness and Involvement; Physical and Mental Health; and Political Awareness and Involvement; and
