Proposed law will result in an increase in SGF expenditures for the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) to take over the operations of the Cecil J. Picard Educational and Recreational Center from the Office of Juvenile Justice (OJJ). Some expenditures will transfer from OJJ to GOHSEP, including While Actually Employed (WAE) employees with related benefits, utilities, supplies, and Office of Risk Management insurance.

GOHSEP reports that there will be an increase in expenditures for the salary, related benefits, and other costs associated with a Branch Manager position, as listed in the table below. ____

In addition, GOHSEP reports an increase in costs for maintenance including recurring costs for an inmate crew and grounds and building maintenance, estimated to be \$102,922 annually, and one-time expenses to purchase a tractor, and associated equipment, and a lawnmower, approximately \$72,357. The table on Page 2 shows a breakdown of the operating and maintenance costs. The LFO cannot corroborate the increased operating and maintenance costs. To the extent any maintenance or operating costs can be transferred from OJJ, GOHSEP may not require the full amount indicated in this fiscal note.

GOHSEP also indicates the roofs across multiple buildings will need major repairs, at an estimated one-time cost of \$188,100. It is unclear at this time whether GOHSEP will need to complete all repairs immediately or if these costs can be spread across multiple fiscal years.
