- 19"(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Section, the state20government and its various departments and institutions may elect to publish public21notices, proclamations, and other advertisements in a printed newspaper and an22associated website if, in his discretion, if will be more efficient, effective, or will23better fulfill a constitutional or statutory obligation if the printed newspaper24possessed a periodical permit and had a general circulation in the state of Louisiana25for at least the previous two years."
