CIVIL/LAW: Prohibits recovery of certain damages for unauthorized aliens

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides an exception to the application of proposed law for an unauthorized alien named as an insured on claims made against an uninsured or underinsured motorist policy.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law defines "unauthorized alien" as a person who is unlawfully present in the U.S. according to the federal Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.).

Proposed law prohibits an award of general damages and past and future wages for unauthorized aliens in an automobile accident. An unauthorized alien is allowed to recover for other special damages.
