WHEREAS, Steve was a passionate supporter of the shooting sports, a lifetime member of the National Rifle Association, a benefactor of the United States Practical Shooting Association, a past president of the Cajun Action Shooters Club, and a reserve deputy in the Iberia Parish Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, he was a man of diverse interests, enjoying wine making, cooking, hunting, fishing, traveling, and especially spending time with his wife Glenda and their family, including traveling the world to support his son Blake's competitive shooting career; and

WHEREAS, Steve's memory and influence will live on through his beloved wife of forty-eight years, Glenda; his sons, Blake and Ridge; his grandchildren, Julianna, Izabel, and Colin; his siblings, and a wide circle of extended family, friends, and community members; and
