- 10 On page 3, delete lines 10 through 13 and insert:

11	"(b) It shall not be considered a violation of Paragraph (A)(3) of this Section
12	if the sole basis for the alleged offense is that the processor, wholesaler, or retailer
13	was operating without an active permit if both of the following occur:
14	(i) The processor, wholesaler, or retailer held a valid permit at the time of
15	applying for permit renewal.
16	(ii) The renewal application was under review by the Louisiana Department
17	of Health or the office of alcohol and tobacco control at the time of the alleged
18	offense.
19	(c) It shall not be considered a violation of Subparagraph (A)(3)(a) of this
20	Section if the consumable hemp product was approved by the Louisiana Department
21	of Health at the time of the alleged offense. If the product's approval has been
22	revoked, no violation shall be deemed to have occurred unless the revocation
23	occurred more than sixty days prior to the alleged offense."
