2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:5002(D)(1) and 5081(B)(1) and (D)(4) and to enact R.S.
3	17:3047.1(H), relative to the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students; to provide
4	relative to TOPS Tech and TOPS Tech Early Start; to provide for eligibility
5	requirements; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:5002(D)(1) and 5081(B)(1) and (D)(4) are hereby amended and
8	reenacted and R.S. 17:3047.1(H) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§3047.1. Advisory council; membership; responsibilities
10	* * *
11	H. The advisory council shall identify programs in which an eligible student
12	may enroll to receive a TOPS-Tech or TOPS-Tech Early Start award. The council
13	shall consider the qualifications for qualified programs for the M.J. Foster Promise
14	Program when identifying such programs.

16	§5002. Awards and amounts

18	D.(1) Except as otherwise provided in this Subsection, a student who is
19	eligible for a TOPS-Tech Award pursuant to this Chapter and who is enrolled:
20	(a) In an eligible public college or university that does not offer an academic
21	undergraduate degree at the baccalaureate level in those associate's degree or other

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shorter-term training and education programs that are aligned to state workforce priorities as determined by the Board of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council, as determined by the advisory council pursuant to R.S. 17:3047.1, shall be awarded by the state an amount determined by the administering agency to equal the tuition charged by the college or university during the 2016-2017 academic year. If the Board of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council determine such council determines that a program is no longer aligned with those priorities, an otherwise eligible student who had previously received an award and enrolled in that program may continue to use the award.

(b) In an eligible college or university other than as provided for in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph in those associate's degree or other shorter-term training education programs that are aligned to state workforce priorities as determined by the Board of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council, as determined by the advisory council pursuant to R.S. 17:3047.1, shall be awarded by the state an amount determined by the administering agency to equal the weighted average of the tuition amounts charged to students attending an eligible public college or university that does not offer an academic undergraduate degree at the baccalaureate level during the 2016-2017 academic year. If the Board of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council determine such council determines that a program is no longer aligned with those priorities, an otherwise eligible student who had previously received an award and enrolled in that program may continue to use the award.

§5081. TOPS-Tech Early Start Award; purpose; eligibility; limitations; administration; implementation; reports

B.(1) A TOPS-Tech Early Start Award may be used to fund any technical or applied course leading to an Industry-Based Certification, a Certificate of Applied Science, and a Certificate of Technical Sciences offered at a Louisiana public or nonpublic postsecondary education institution or by any Louisiana training provider

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1	recognized by the Louisiana Workforce Commission and approved by the State
2	Board of Elementary and Secondary Education as provided in Paragraph (4) of this
3	Subsection when such certification or certificate is approved by the Workforce
4	Investment Council as meeting the following requirements: qualified program, as
5	determined by the advisory council pursuant to R.S. 17:3047.1.
6	(a) Is identified by the Occupation Forecasting Conference as a credential
7	for an occupation in top demand in Louisiana.
8	(b) Is recognized by the State Industry-Based Certification Leadership
9	Council.

11	D. To be eligible for an initial TOPS-Tech Early Start Award, a student shall
12	meet each of the following conditions and comply with other applicable provisions
13	of this Section and administering agency rules:

15	(4) Meet one of the following:
16	(a) Score at least fifteen on the English subsection and fifteen on the
17	mathematics subsection of the ACT PLAN assessment or a successor assessment
18	administered as part of Louisiana's Educational Planning and Assessment System or
19	the ACT or an equivalent concordant value of the SAT.
20	(b) or have attained Attain a silver level score on the assessments of the ACT
21	WorkKeys system.
22	(c) Meet the eligibility requirements for technical dual enrollment courses
23	as determined by the Board of Regents.

25	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply to awards for the 2026-2027 school
26	year and thereafter.
27	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
28	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
29	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

1	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become		
2	effective on the day following such approval.
