SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 169

COMMENDATIONS. Commends Deputy Gregory Brant Aydell on his selection as recipient of the Louisiana Sheriff's Association's Deputy Valor Award.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To commend Deputy Gregory Brant Aydell of the Livingston Parish Sheriff's Office upon
3	being named the recipient of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association's 2025 Deputy Valor
4	Award for acts of extraordinary bravery and lifesaving service beyond the call of
5	duty.
6	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association and its president, Sheriff K.P.
7	Gibson, along with the Association's Awards Committee, have selected Deputy Gregory
8	Brant Aydell to receive the 2025 Deputy Valor Award, the organization's highest honor
9	recognizing extreme acts of courage and heroism; and
10	WHEREAS, Deputy Aydell's valorous service in 2025 was nothing short of
11	extraordinary, as he saved three lives in separate incidents, including two within the span of
12	just forty-eight hours; and
13	WHEREAS, on March 13, 2024, Deputy Aydell responded to an overdose call where
14	the victim was unconscious and not breathing; he immediately initiated rescue breathing and
15	continued for five to ten minutes until medics arrived and administered multiple doses of
16	Narcan, eventually reviving the individual through continued CPR; a life saved because of
17	his swift action and persistence; and
18	WHEREAS, on April 3, 2024, Deputy Aydell and Deputy Landon Adams responded

1	to a reported leg gunshot wound, only to discover the victim had actually been shot in the
2	chest; drawing upon his training, Deputy Aydell applied a chest seal and helped position the
3	victim for easier breathing until medics arrived and performed emergency decompression,
4	saving the victim's life; and
5	WHEREAS, just forty hours later, on April 5, 2024, Deputy Aydell and Deputy
6	Brandon Ma responded to the scene of a three-year-old child drowning; Deputy Aydell
7	immediately began rescue breathing, then continued lifesaving efforts en route to the
8	hospital in the backseat of a unit driven by Deputy Ma; the child was revived at the hospital
9	and survived, thanks to their quick-thinking and coordination; and
10	WHEREAS, Deputy Aydell's commitment to duty is shaped by a remarkable
11	journey: raised in Livingston Parish under challenging circumstances, including exposure
12	to drug abuse and instability, he sought a new path by joining the United States Army after
13	graduating from Walker High School; and
14	WHEREAS, his military service is distinguished and commendable: he served as a
15	member of the elite 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment with seven deployments to Iraq
16	and Afghanistan, earning the Purple Heart with oak leaf cluster, Army Commendation Medal
17	with Valor device, and numerous other commendations for valor, leadership, and service;
18	and
19	WHEREAS, following his medical retirement in 2016, Deputy Aydell returned to
20	his home parish to raise a family, earned a degree in Chemical Process Technology, and
21	continued his calling to serve through law enforcement, joining the Livingston Parish
22	Sheriff's Office in 2022 as a patrol deputy; and
23	WHEREAS, in his tenure with the Sheriff's Office, Deputy Aydell has not only saved
24	lives, but also worked to remove illegal drugs and firearms from the community, earning the
25	Meritorious Service Award, three lifesaving awards, and a Letter of Commendation; and
26	WHEREAS, Deputy Aydell exemplifies the courage, compassion, and
27	professionalism expected of Louisiana's finest, and his heroic actions bring great honor to
28	the Livingston Parish Sheriff's Office, the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association, and the law
29	enforcement profession.
30	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana

does hereby commend Deputy Gregory Brant Aydell for his unwavering bravery and

lifesaving actions, and congratulates him upon receiving the Louisiana Sheriffs'

Association's 2025 Deputy Valor Award.
