

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 65

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend the Episcopal School of Baton Rouge on their athletic achievements and outstanding performances in the Louisiana High School Athletic Association State Championships.

WHEREAS, the Episcopal boys' cross country team captured the 2024 Division III state title, with participants individually placing sixth, tenth, sixteenth, seventeenth, eighteenth, twentieth, and twenty-first; and

WHEREAS, the girls' cross country team achieved an impressive second-place finish in the 2024 Division III state championship, with participants individually placing third, fourth, eighth, twentieth, twenty-second, thirtieth, and thirty-sixth; and

WHEREAS, the girls' swimming team captured the 2024 Division III state championship with a dominant performance, including individual first place finishes in the two hundred-yard medley relay, two hundred-yard freestyle, two hundred-yard individual medley relay, one hundred-yard freestyle, five hundred-yard freestyle, two hundred-yard freestyle relay, one hundred-yard backstroke, and one hundred-yard breaststroke, and was led by the 2024 Outstanding Female Swimmer of the Meet; and

WHEREAS, the boys' track and field team captured the 2025 Class AA state championship behind a series of impressive performances, including a first place finish in the four-by-eight hundred meter relay; and

WHEREAS, the girls' track and field team captured the 2025 Class AA state championship with a number of athletes contributing, including first place finishes in the four-by-eight hundred meter relay and the thirty-two hundred meter run; and

WHEREAS, the boys' powerlifting team secured the 2025 Division IV state championship, highlighted by participants finishing first in three weight classes, second in one weight class, and third in four weight classes, with Episcopal athletes earning Lifters of the Meet honors on both the light and heavy platforms; and

WHEREAS, the girls' golf team earned the 2025 Division II state runner-up title, with individual participants placing second, seventh, and nineteenth overall; and

WHEREAS, the girls' tennis team achieved an impressive third-place finish in the 2025 Division III state championship, including the individual state championship in singles; and

WHEREAS, these accomplishments reflect the hard work and commitment of the student-athletes, coaches, and supporting staff of the Episcopal School of Baton Rouge athletic programs.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Episcopal School of Baton Rouge for their athletic success and for their outstanding championship performances in boys' and girls' cross country, track and field, swimming, powerlifting, golf, and tennis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Episcopal School of Baton Rouge.
