Report adopts Senate amendments to:

1. Remove authority for the La. State Board of Dentistry to locate its office in any parish.

Report amends the bill to:

1. Make technical changes.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

<u>Present law</u> provides for the La. State Board of Dentistry (board), and provides that the board shall be domiciled in East Baton Rouge Parish.

Proposed law instead provides that the board shall be domiciled in Orleans Parish.
