MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Reduces the fee applicable to updating a driver's license to comply with REAL ID standards to a handling fee

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds a termination date for <u>proposed law</u> of June 30, 2026.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> requires the office of motor vehicles collect, in addition to any fee authorized by law, a handling charge of \$12 for each duplicate Class "D" and "E" driver's license transactions.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that an applicant seeking to update a driver's license to become REAL ID compliant prior to the renewal eligibility of the driver's license is exempt from the fee imposed in <u>present law</u> for the issuance of a duplicate license. Additionally, requires the applicant pay the handling fee as set forth in present law.

Proposed law specifies that the REAL ID exemption terminates on June 30, 2026.
