Proposed legislation provides a framework permitting a city, parish, or other local school system to provide mental health screenings for all kindergarten through grade 12 students during the first semester of each academic year. Provides that the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) is to develop a list of mental health screening tools and community resources and to provide this information to the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) for distribution to local school systems. Provides for confidentiality of testing results and prohibits schools from using the results to make decisions concerning student instruction and discipline.
