1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:5029(B)(2) and (3)(a) and (b)(ii) and (iii), relative to the
3	Taylor Opportunity Program for Students; to provide relative to the alternate
4	eligibility requirements for students who complete approved home study programs;
5	to lower the minimum ACT score such students must attain for initial qualification
6	for an award; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:5029(B)(2) and (3)(a) and (b)(ii) and (iii) are hereby amended and
9	reenacted to read as follows:
10	§5029. Alternative initial eligibility requirements
11	* * *
12	B. A student who completes a home study program shall be eligible to
13	receive an award pursuant to this Chapter if each of the following conditions is met:
14	* * *
15	(2) The student meets the requirements of R.S. 17:5022, 5023, <u>5024(B)(1)</u> ,
16	5027, and 5028.

9	(ii) For a student qualifying for an initial TOPS-Tech or Opportunity Award
10	for the 2008-2009 award year or thereafter through the 2024-2025 award year
11	pursuant to this Subsection, the student shall have a composite score on the 1990
12	version of the ACT which is at least two points higher than that required by R.S.
13	17:5024(B) for the particular award or an equivalent concordant value on an
14	enhanced or revised version of such test or on the SAT.
15	(iii) For a student qualifying for an initial Performance or Honors Award for
16	the 2008-2009 award year or thereafter through the 2024-2025 award year pursuant
17	to this Subsection, the student shall have a composite score on the 1990 version of
18	the ACT which is at least one point higher than that required by R.S. 17:5024(B) for
19	the particular award or an equivalent concordant value on an enhanced or revised
20	version of such test or on the SAT.
