5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 22:836(B)(9) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§836. Retaliatory taxes and fees; insurance premium tax credits for retaliatory taxes
8	paid by certain domestic insurers

12	(9) No credit authorized pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection shall
13	be granted for retaliatory taxes based upon insurance premiums written in other
14	states after December 31, 2029 December 31, 2031.
15	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
16	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
17	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
18	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
19	effective on the day following such approval.
