A RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Senate Committee on Judiciary B to study recent technological advancements regarding lotteries and determine whether such advancements conform with Louisiana law.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Lottery Corporation has generated revenue for K-12 public education and local philanthropic events and festivals in Louisiana since 1991; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Lottery Corporation ended its 2024 fiscal year with over six hundred forty-two million dollars in revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Lottery Corporation has been nationally recognized for its innovation; and

WHEREAS, over the last thirty years, the Louisiana Lottery Corporation has embraced new technologies and new games in an effort to serve its mission; and

WHEREAS, recently developed technology contemplates multiple points of sale in large retail outlets through in-lane check-out systems; and

WHEREAS, many technological advancements could not have been contemplated by the citizens of Louisiana when they approved the lottery in 1990.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Senate Committee on Judiciary B to study recent technological advancements regarding lotteries and determine whether such advancements conform with Louisiana law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the president of the Louisiana Lottery Corporation.
