ACT 89 (SB 4) 2025 Regular Session Lambert

<u>Existing law</u> prohibits erection, display, or posting of political campaign signs on any publicly owned property or right of way, or to or on any public utility pole or stanchion.

<u>New law</u> retains this prohibition but makes an exception subject to school board policy to allow political campaign signs erected, displayed, or posted on the premises of any public school athletic field or public school gymnasium if paid for by the political candidate or political campaign.

Existing law prohibits certain acts during early voting of or on election day.

New law provides that existing law is not to be construed as an exception to this prohibition.

Effective August 1, 2025.
