<u>Existing law</u> provides that certain city courts, including the City Court of Hammond, have jurisdiction concurrent with district courts in cases where the amount in dispute, or the value of the property involved, does not exceed \$30,000.

Existing law provides that certain other city courts have jurisdiction concurrent with the district courts in cases where the amount in dispute, or the value of the property involved, does not exceed \$50,000.

<u>New law</u> removes the City Court of Hammond from the list of city courts having concurrent jurisdiction with district courts in cases where the amount in dispute, or the value of the property involved, does not exceed \$30,000, and adds the City Court of Hammond to the list of city courts having concurrent jurisdiction with district courts where the amount in dispute, or the value of the property involved, does not exceed \$50,000.

Effective August 1, 2025.
