## ACT 23 (SB 9)

Existing law prohibits operating an "unmanned aircraft system" (UAS) over certain areas without prior written authorization.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and defines and adds "federal or state military installations or facilities" to the list of places over which operating a UAS is prohibited without prior written authorization.

Existing law provides penalties for operating a UAS over certain areas without prior written authorization.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and adds that operating a UAS over federal or state military installations or facilities without prior written authorization will be punished by a fine between \$2,000 and \$5,000 and imprisonment at hard labor for up to five years. <u>New law</u> further provides for forfeiture and disposal of the UAS.

Effective August 1, 2025.
