**ACT 46 (HB 23)**

**Muscarello**

Existing law requires a sheriff to prepare a statement showing how long a defendant has spent in custody prior to a conviction.

Existing law requires the clerk of court to prepare a copy of the indictment and a copy of the Uniform Sentencing Commitment Order.

Prior law required the clerk of court to send the documents required by existing law to the sheriff of the parish where the defendant was sentenced.

New law requires the law enforcement agency that had custody of the defendant to submit the documents required by existing law (C.Cr.P. Art. 892) electronically using the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System.

Effective August 1, 2025.
