Existing law provides that first degree murder is the killing of a human being when the offender has specific intent to kill or inflict great bodily harm and is engaged in the perpetration or attempted perpetration of certain crimes.

<u>New law</u> adds cruelty to the elderly and persons with infirmities to that list of crimes.

Existing law provides that second degree murder is the killing of a human being when the offender is engaged in the perpetration or attempted perpetration of certain crimes, even when the offender has no intent to kill or inflict great bodily harm.

<u>New law</u> adds cruelty to the elderly and persons with infirmities to that list of crimes.

Effective August 1, 2025.
