ACT 219 (HB 63)

Existing constitution provides that a judge shall not remain in office beyond his 70th birthday, but also provides that he may remain in office until the completion of his term if he attains 70 years of age while serving a term of office.

Proposed constitutional amendment changes the mandatory age of retirement to 75 from 70 years of age.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held April 18, 2026.
