BY SENATOR JENKINS

PUBLIC MEETINGS. Provides for electronic voting requirements under the Open Meetings Law. (8/1/26)

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 42:14(C), relative to the Open Meetings Law; to provide for viva voce voting; to provide for electronic voting; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S.42:14(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§14. Meetings of public bodies to be open to the public

* * *

C. All votes made by members of a public body shall be viva voce and shall be recorded in the minutes, journal, or other official, written proceedings of the body, which shall be a public document. **Electronic machines which display and record how an individual member of a public body votes shall be deemed to satisfy the concept of viva voce voting and thus, satisfy the voting requirements of the Open Meetings Law, R.S. 42:11 et seq.**

* * *

Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be applied retroactively.

Present law relative to the Open Meetings Law, provides for the recordation of votes made by members of public body in the minutes, journal, or other official, written proceedings of the body and shall be a public document.

Proposed law provides that a vote displayed by an electronic machine shall satisfy viva voce voting and the Open Meetings Law.

Proposed law provides for the retroactive application of this Act.

Effective August 1, 2026.
