RETIREMENT SYSTEMS. Changes the name and design of the "State Employee Retired" prestige license plate. (8/1/26)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 47:463.142(A), (B), and (E), relative to motor vehicle special
3 prestige license plates; to provide for the creation, issuance, design, and fee
4 disbursement of the "RSEA" specialty prestige license plate; and to provide for
5 related matters.

6 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 47:463.142(A), (B), and (E) are hereby amended and reenacted to
9 read as follows:

10 §463.142. Special prestige license plate; "State Employee Retired RSEA"

Louisiana centered on the left side of the license plate and shall display the state seal centered inside of the outline of the state shape. The ~~words word~~ "State Employee ~~Retired RSEA~~" shall be centered under the "Louisiana" name logo at the top of the plate. The center of the plate shall display a number, with the first issued plate displaying the number one and shall continue in consecutive numerical order for each plate. Centered at the bottom of the plate below the number shall be the ~~words~~ "Louisiana State Employees Retirement System" the RSEA logo.

Present law requires the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to issue special prestige license plates with the designated, "State Employee Retired".

Proposed law retains present law but changes the name and design of the special prestige license plate from "State Employee Retired" to "RSEA".

Present law provides for an initial fee of \$25, which is remitted to the Louisiana State

Employees' Retirement System and used to pay down the system's unfunded accrued liability.
