**Abstract:** Removes Vermilion Parish as a member of the Acadiana Regional Juvenile Justice District.

Present law (R.S. 15:1109) provides for the membership of the Acadiana Regional Juvenile Justice District.

Proposed law amends present law to remove Vermilion Parish as a member. Otherwise retains present law.

Present law (R.S. 15:1109.1) provides for the membership of the Acadiana Regional Juvenile Justice District Commission.

Proposed law amends present law to reduce the number of commissioners from 11 to 10 and removes from the commission a qualified elector who is domiciled and residing within Vermilion Parish, who is jointly appointed by the chief judge and district attorney for the 15<sup>th</sup> JDC and the sheriff of Vermilion Parish. Otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
