Abstract: Provides an exception for recovery available to a driver without compulsory motor vehicle liability security.

Present law (R.S. 32:866) provides that there is no recovery for the first \$100,000 of bodily injury or property damage for injuries or damages occasioned by an owner or operator of a motor vehicle who fails to own or maintain compulsory motor vehicle liability security.

Proposed law retains present law and also provides that there is no recovery for bodily injury or property damage for a driver with a lapse in coverage that exceeds 30 days.
