ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Designates the Bayou Dularge Bascule Bridge located in Terrebonne Parish as the "Elward T. Brady Bridge". (8/1/26)

AN ACT

To provide relative to state highways; to designate the Bayou Dularge Bascule Bridge in Terrebonne Parish as the "Elward T. Brady Memorial Bridge"; to provide for location and placement of signage; to provide for restrictions on costs of materials to the department; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the bascule bridge that connects to Louisiana Highway 315 in Terrebonne Parish, that is elevated over the body of water known as Intracoastal Waterway, is hereby designated as the "Elward T. Brady Memorial Bridge".

Section 2. (A) The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars per sign.

(B) To the extent that sufficient additional local or private monies are received, signage provided for by this Act shall also be placed on either side of the bascule bridge

1 for visibility to crossing water craft.

Designates the bascule bridge connected to Louisiana Highway 315 known as the Bayou Dularge Bascule Bridge in Terrebonne Parish as the "Elward T. Brady Memorial Bridge".

Directs DOTD to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided certain cost restrictions are satisfied.

Effective August 1, 2026.
