

1 and work in Louisiana after graduation.

2 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
3 establish and provide for the Anchor Home Task Force to study the feasibility of offering
4 tax credits to incentivize the hiring of resident Louisiana college graduates to live and work
5 in Louisiana during the first five years after graduation.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall propose recommendations,
7 by written report to the legislature and to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library,
8 as required by R.S. 24:771 and 772, no later than April 1, 2027.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force should include consideration of
10 the following:

11 (1) Type of incentive and financial structure.

12 (2) Strategic alignment with workforce needs.

13 (3) Targeting and eligibility criteria.

14 (4) Implementation and sustainability, including a comparison of average
15 compensation for targeted jobs within Louisiana and within the southern or other regional
16 average, maximum annual state financial obligation for the incentive, agency selection for
17 administration of the incentive program, and metrics by which to assess the success of the
18 incentive program.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall consist of the following
20 members:

21 (1) The senator from Senate District 20 who shall serve as chairman of the task force.

22 (2) Two members of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate.

23 (3) Three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the
24 House of Representatives.

25 (4) The secretary of the Department of Revenue, or his designee.

26 (5) The secretary of Louisiana Economic Development, or his designee.

27 (6) The secretary of Louisiana Works, or his designee.

28 (7) One member appointed by the Louisiana Association of Business and Industry.

29 (8) The commissioner of higher education, or his designee.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each designating authority shall submit the
