A RESOLUTION

To recognize March 23, 2026, as Thrive Day at the Louisiana State Capitol, and to commend Thrive Academy and the Thrive Foundation for their commitment to expanding educational opportunities for students across the state of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Thrive Academy is a public boarding school located in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, that serves students from communities across the state and provides an educational environment designed to prepare young people for academic success, leadership, and lifelong opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Class of 2026, the largest graduating class in Thrive Academy's history, is present at the Louisiana State Capitol in recognition of Thrive Day and serves as a testament to the school's continued growth and impact on students across Louisiana.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Monday, March 23, 2026, as Thrive Day at the Louisiana State Capitol, and commends Thrive Academy and the Thrive Foundation for their commitment to expanding educational opportunities for students across the state of Louisiana.
