1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 10, change "Tuesday, December 29, 2026," to "Monday, April 10, 2028,"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 3, delete line 22 and insert the following:

5 "from Monday, April 10, 2028, through Sunday, October 15, 2028."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 4, line 4, after "held on" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 5 and insert:

8 "Saturday, March 25, 2028. The candidate that receives the highest number of votes
9 shall be elected. If more than one candidate receives the highest number of votes, the
10 delegate shall be selected by a public drawing of lots conducted by the State Board
11 of Election Supervisors from among the candidates who received the highest number
12 of votes in the election. The public drawing of lots shall be conducted at the state
13 capitol on a day and at a time fixed by the board within one week after the results of
14 the election become official. The candidates involved shall be given at least three
15 days' written notice of the time and place of the public drawing of lots. The"

24 (2) A candidate for delegate who qualifies to be elected from a district from
25 which members of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana are elected shall be
26 considered a local candidate and shall qualify with the clerk of court for the parish
27 in which the candidate is registered to vote. The candidate shall pay a qualifying fee
28 of three hundred dollars. In addition to this fee, a candidate shall pay an additional
29 qualifying fee of twenty-five dollars, which additional fee shall be deposited into the
30 Campaign Sign Recycling Fund as provided in R.S. 18:454.

31 (3) A candidate for delegate who qualifies to be elected from a district from
32 which commissioners of the Public Service Commission are elected shall be
33 considered a state candidate and shall qualify with the secretary of state or a person
34 in his office designated to receive qualifying papers. The candidate shall pay a
35 qualifying fee of four hundred fifty dollars. In addition to this fee, a candidate shall
36 pay an additional qualifying fee of twenty-five dollars, which additional fee shall be
37 deposited into the Campaign Sign Recycling Fund as provided in R.S. 18:454.
