HUMAN TRAFFICKING EG NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1  
Provides relative to bail conditions for defendants alleged to have committed certain human trafficking offenses

Current law provides for bail conditions for defendants who are alleged to have committed crimes of violence. Proposed law requires the court, as a condition of bail, to impose a restriction that a defendant who is alleged to have committed the offense of human trafficking or trafficking of children for sexual purposes refrain from contacting, communicating, or physically interacting with the victim and provides for limited exceptions for when the offender is permitted communication; requires the court, as a condition of bail, to impose a restriction that a defendant who is alleged to have committed the offense of human trafficking or trafficking of children for sexual purposes refrain from engaging in certain forms of employment.
