A RESOLUTION

To commend Noreen E. Little on the occasion of her election as national president of Phi Delta Kappa, Incorporated, and to recognize her service, leadership, and contributions to education.

WHEREAS, Ms. Little has been a committed member of the National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Incorporated, Eastern Region, Beta Omicron Chapter in Jamaica, New York, since 1986; she has held numerous chapter offices including basileus, second anti-basileus, tamiouchos, grammateus, and dean of pledges; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Little has provided distinguished leadership at the regional level by serving as kudos chair, tamiouchos, audit chair, and parliamentarian; she served as elected eastern region director in 2015 and played an instrumental role in reactivating the Epsilon Sigma Chapter in Gastonia, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Little co-chaired the 2009 Youth Leadership Conference, chaired the 2024 Eastern Region Conference, and was named a Diamond Life Member in 2019; after being elected first supreme anti-basileus, she launched the NSPDK, Incorporated, e-Learning Academy and implemented a town hall series to deliver timely professional content to members; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Little is supported by her husband, Allan, and their three adult children; her election as national president of the National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Incorporated, is a testament to her sustained commitment to educational excellence, organizational service, and the development of youth and professional members.
