To commend the Denham Springs High School Robotics Team on winning the FIRST Robotics Pikes Peak Regional Competition.

WHEREAS, the Denham Springs High School Robotics Team, Denham Venom, captured a victory at the FIRST Robotics Pikes Peak Regional Competition in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and secured a place in the 2026 FIRST World Championship in Houston, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Denham Venom defeated a field a thirty-three teams, including international competitors from Mexico and Taiwan; with the victory, the team rose to fifteenth in the world rankings, thirteenth in the United States, and first in Louisiana; and
