 Requires each public school to incorporate instruction on artificial intelligence into an existing course of study for each student in grades six through twelve
 Proposed legislation requires each public school to incorporate instruction on artificial intelligence into an existing course of study for students in grades six through twelve. Directs the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to adopt rules as necessary for the implementation of this requirement.



EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION
 Proposed legislation is not anticipated to result in a direct material effect on state or local governmental expenditures. Present law (Act 211 of the 2024 RS) requires instruction in computer science for students in grades six through twelve, which the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) reports includes instruction on the fundamental concepts of artificial intelligence.

Note: Proposed legislation authorizes the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to promulgate rules for the implementation of instruction in artificial intelligence. To the extent BESE adopts rules that significantly expand instructional requirements beyond current practice, local school systems could incur indeterminable costs; however, any such impact is not anticipated based on current instructional standards.
