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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 17 in their entirety and on page 2 delete lines 1 and 2 in  
3 their entirety and insert the following:

4 **"(2) "Purchase agreement" means a written act through which**  
5 **unclaimed property is sold, assigned, or transferred, or purported to be so, by**  
6 **an apparent owner for consideration. It includes any amendments, attachments,**  
7 **and exhibits."**

8 AMENDMENT NO. 2

9 On page 2, delete lines 13 through 14 in their entirety

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 2, at the beginning of line 15, change "**(b)**" to "**(a)**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 2, at the beginning of line 16, change "**(c)**" to "**(b)**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 2, at the beginning of line 18, change "**(d)**" to "**(c)**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 On page 2, at the beginning of line 20, change "**(e)**" to "**(d)**"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 2, at the beginning of line 23, change "**(f)**" to "**(e)**"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 2, between lines 25 and 26, insert the following:

22 **"(f) The name of any entity that the seller acquired or merged with, if the**  
23 **purchase agreement includes property of an apparent owner that the seller**  
24 **merged with or acquired."**

25 AMENDMENT NO. 9

26 On page 3, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

27 **"(e) If applicable, proof that the seller had the right to sell, assign, or**  
28 **otherwise transfer unclaimed property of which the apparent owner of the**  
29 **unclaimed property is an entity that the seller merged with or acquired.**

30 **(f) Proof required pursuant to Subparagraphs (d) and (e) of this**  
31 **Paragraph may be provided by the submission of an extract of the pertinent**  
32 **records. The individual who signed the purchase agreement shall provide an**

1 affidavit along with the extract affirming that the extract constitutes valid  
2 evidence of the underlying action. The administrator may require the full  
3 documents to be provided if he finds the extract to be ambiguous or  
4 incomplete."

5 AMENDMENT NO. 10

6 On page 3, at the end of line 22, delete "sale or purchase of" and insert "sale, purchase, or  
7 transfer of"
