Present law provides that fuel sold at a price below the retailer's cost constitutes an unfair trade practice.

Proposed law provides for an exemption to present law when fuel is purchased using fuel rewards points earned through a loyalty program, fuel rewards program, or other discount fuel program.

Proposed law provides that the discount outlined in proposed law shall not exceed \$1.00 below the advertised price.

Effective August 1, 2026.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Commerce to the engrossed bill:

1. Make technical changes.
2. Add an exemption to proposed law that prohibits a limit on the allowable discount of fuel purchased with reward points.
3. Add that the discount outlined in proposed law shall not exceed \$1.00 below the advertised price.
