Hilferty

Existing law creates the Lakeview Crime Prevention District in Orleans Parish as a political subdivision to aid in crime prevention and add to the security of the district residents by providing for an increase in the presence of law enforcement personnel in the district. Provides for district boundaries, governance, and powers and duties.

Existing law authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans, subject to voter approval, to impose and collect a parcel fee within the district. Requires that the fee be imposed on each parcel within the district, whether such parcel is improved or unimproved.

Prior law provided that the fee amount would be as requested by duly adopted resolution of the board, not to exceed \$150 per parcel per year.

New law increases the maximum fee authorized to be imposed within the district from \$150 to \$250 per parcel per year.

Effective August 1, 2026.
