ACT 763 (SB 382)

Existing law provides that the reimbursement schedule includes charges limited to the mean of the usual and customary charges for care, services, treatment, drugs, and supplies. Existing law allows annual adjustments.

New law retains existing law and requires the assistant secretary to reassess the reimbursement schedule and implement necessary adjustments to the schedule by July 1, 2029.

Existing law creates the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council (council) within La. Works. Existing law further provides that the council consists of 17 members who are domiciled in Louisiana and appointed by the governor to serve at the pleasure of the governor. Existing law further provides relative to the duties of the council and members' immunity from liability under certain circumstances. Existing law further requires the council to review and make recommendations to the governor, through La. Works, on any proposed rules affecting the administration or resolution of claims.

New law repeals existing law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
