Existing law prohibits a person who is required to have an ignition interlock device from operating a vehicle without one or requesting another person to blow into the device.

Existing law states that this prohibition applies to persons required to have an ignition interlock device pursuant to existing law relative to bail (R.S. 15:306).

New law adds that persons required to have an ignition interlock device pursuant to existing law relative to probation (C.Cr.P. 320(C)) are also prohibited from operating a vehicle without one or requesting another person to blow into the device.

Effective August 1, 2026.
