Existing law authorizes any person who has properly obtained a microbrewer's permit as provided for in existing law to engage in the brewing of beer and other malt beverages in a quantity not to exceed 12,500 barrels during the licensed year.

Existing law authorizes the holder of the microbrewer's permit to sell the manufactured beverages at retail for consumption on or off the licensed premises, if the holder also has been issued a Retailer, Class A permit.

Existing law of the La. Admin. Code (LAC Title 55, Part VII, Subpart 1 §323(B)) defines a special event as an event held at any location, where alcoholic beverages are served as an incidental part of the event for payment or are supplied as a part of a general admission or other type of fee.

New law allows the holder of a microbrewer's permit and a Class A permit to sell beverages at special events through not more than 12 permits if the special event permits are issued in the same name as the microbrewer's permit.

Effective August 1, 2026.
