Phelps

Existing law provides for the issuance and regulation of various high and low alcoholic beverage permits.

Prior law prohibited the additional issuance of permits for the sale of high or low alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from Aug. 1, 2025, through Dec. 31, 2026.

New law prohibits the additional issuance of permits for the sale of *high* alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from Aug. 1, 2025, through Dec. 31, 2027.

New law prohibits the additional issuance of permits for the sale of *low* alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from Aug. 1, 2025, through Dec. 31, 2032.

New law provides for an exception for national chain restaurants or stores. Further defines "national chain" as a company that operates in 10 or more states.

Effective August 1, 2026.
