Existing constitution provides that a person who has served as governor for more than one and one-half terms in two consecutive terms shall not be elected governor for the succeeding term.

Proposed constitutional amendment provides that a person who has served as governor for more than one and one-half terms shall not be elected governor.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held November 3, 2026.
