ACT 394 (HB 67)

Bacala

Existing law (R.S. 44:11.2) limits access to personal information of protected individuals. Further defines the individuals who fall within the class of a "protected individual" as it relates to existing law. Provides for the instances when a protected individual's personal information shall not be published and when a protected individual may request the removal of publicly posted personal information.

Existing law provides for an exception to the prohibition on the publication of personal information of protected individuals. Provides that a protected individual is not exempt from the publication of his personal information by the office of the secretary of state. Further provides that a protected individual is not entitled to request the removal of his personal information when publicly posted by the office of the secretary of state.

New law additionally provides that a protected individual is not exempt from the publication of his personal information by a district clerk of court or the board of ethics. Further provides that a protected individual is not entitled to request the removal of his personal information when publicly posted by a district clerk of court or the board of ethics.

Effective August 1, 2026.
