Knox

Existing law provides for the crime of hit-and-run driving and applicable penalties.

New law provides for penalties as follows:

- (1) For a violation of existing law (R.S. 14:100(C)(2)), a requirement that at least two years of the sentence imposed be served without the benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence if the victim is a pedestrian or a bicyclist.
- (2) For a violation of existing law (R.S. 14:100(C)(3)), a requirement that at least five years of the sentence imposed be served without the benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence if the victim is a pedestrian or a bicyclist.

New law may be cited and referred to as the "Christina Larsen Act".

Effective August 1, 2026.
