Existing law provides relative to the disclosure of financial records.

Prior law defined "supervisory agency" as any entity that has statutory authority to examine the financial condition, business operations, records, or transactions of a bank, including the federal Office of Thrift Supervision.

New law amends prior law to change the federal Office of Thrift Supervision to the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau.

Existing law provides for methods of service of a disclosure demand for financial records to various entities.

New law adds to existing law to provide for service of disclosure demand to limited liability companies.

Effective August 1, 2026.
