CHILD DAY CARE FACILITY: Relative to discrimination in day care centers and breast-fed babies

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 46:1409(B)(5) and 1413(E), relative to child care
3 facilities; to prohibit discrimination against breast-fed babies; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 46:1409(B)(5) and 1413(E) are hereby amended and
7 reenacted to read as follows:

8 §1409. Rules, regulations and standards for Class A licenses

9 * * *

10 B. The Louisiana Advisory Committee on Licensing of Child
11 Care Facilities and Child-Placing Agencies shall approve rules and
12 regulations developed by the department to meet at least the following
13 standards for all Class A child care facilities and child placement
14 agencies as defined in this Chapter which, at a minimum, shall:

15 * * *

16 (5) Prohibit discrimination by child care facilities and child
17 placement agencies on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, national

1 origin, handicapping condition, ~~or ancestry, or whether the child is~~
2 being breast-fed. A provider shall have a written description of
3 admission policies and criteria which expresses the needs, problems,
4 situations, or patterns best addressed by its program. These policies
5 shall be available to the legally responsible person for any child
6 referred for placement.

8 §1413. Rules, regulations, and standards for Class B licenses

9 * * *

10 E. No child care facility shall discriminate based on race, color,
11 creed, disability, as defined in R.S. 51:2232(11), national origin, ~~or~~
12 ancestry, or whether the child is being breast-fed. However, this shall
13 not restrict the hiring or admission policies of a church or religious
14 organization, which may give preference in hiring or admission to
15 members of the church or denomination. Nor shall it affect the rights
16 of religious sectarian child-placing agencies to consider creed in any
17 decision or action relating to foster care or adoption.

Abstract: Prohibits discrimination against breast-fed babies by child care facilities.

Present law (R.S. 46:1409(B)(5)) prohibits Class A child care facilities from discriminating based on race, color, creed, disability, national origin, and ancestry.

Proposed law retains present law but also prohibits discrimination against babies that are breast-fed.

Present law (R.S.46: 1413(E)) prohibits discrimination among Class B child care facilities based on race, color, creed, disability, national origin, and ancestry.

Proposed law retains present law but also prohibits discrimination against babies that are breast-fed.
