#### DIGEST

Present law authorizes the Recovery School District (RSD) to acquire all rights and responsibilities of ownership regarding all land, buildings, facilities, and other property that is part of schools performing below the state average that are deemed as failing and transferred to the RSD from a school system academically in crisis.

Proposed law requires the RSD to develop a plan detailing the current and intended use of land, buildings, facilities, and other property that are a part of such transferred schools not later than June 16, 2008.

Proposed law further requires the RSD to return stewardship and control of all land, buildings, facilities, and other property for which the required plan provides for no future use as a school or a school site to the transferring school system.

Effective August 15, 2007.
