LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates Sazerac as the official state cocktail. (8/15/08)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 49:170.15, relative to state symbols; to designate the Sazerac as the official
3	state cocktail; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 49:170.15 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§170.15. State cocktail
7	There shall be an official state cocktail. The official state cocktail shall
8	be the Sazerac. The Sazerac, created in the nineteenth century by Antoine
9	Amedee Peychaud in the French Quarter of New Orleans, is world known for
10	the use of a local product known as "Peychaud's Bitters." Its use on official
11	documents of the state and with the insignia of the state is hereby authorized.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes Sazerac as the official state cocktail and authorizes its use on official documents and with the state insignia.

Effective on August 15, 2008.
