LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates Sazerac as the official cocktail of the city of New Orleans. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 49:170.15, relative to state symbols; to designate the Sazerac as the official
3	cocktail of the city of New Orleans; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 49:170.15 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	<u>§170.15. New Orleans cocktail</u>
7	<u>There shall be an official cocktail of the city of New Orleans. The official</u>
8	New Orleans cocktail shall be the Sazerac. The Sazerac, created in the
9	<u>nineteenth century by Antoine Amedee Peychaud in the French Quarter of New</u>
10	Orleans, is world known for the use of a local product known as ''Peychaud's
11	Bitters." Its use on official documents of the city of New Orleans and with the
12	insignia of the city of New Orleans is hereby authorized.
13	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
14	or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
15	without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
16	Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
17	the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
