1	AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On Page 274, after line 47, insert the following:

- 3 "Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct) 4 for one-time salary supplements of \$300 5 for noncertificated support personnel 6 employed by local school systems and for 7 unclassified, noncertificated support 8 personnel employed by the Office of Youth 9 Development, the Louisiana School for the 10 Visually Impaired, the Louisiana School for the 11 Deaf, the Louisiana Special Education Center, the Louisiana School for Math, Science and the 12 13 Arts, the New Orleans Center for the Creative 14 Arts - Riverfront, the Southern University and 15 LSU Lab Schools, the Special School Districts, and for nonpublic lunchroom employees 16 17 eligible for state salary supplements \$ 11,500,000
- 18Provided, however, that the one-time salary supplements shall be19implemented only in the event that the official Fiscal Year 2002-200320Revenue Estimating Conference forecast adopted after July 1, 2002,21exceeds both the official Fiscal Year 2002-2003 Revenue Estimating22Conference forecast adopted on April 30, 2002, and any and all23revenues enacted into law as a result of the 2002 Regular Session of the24Louisiana Legislature.
- Provided, further, that in the event that the official Fiscal Year
 26 2002-2003 Revenue Estimating Conference forecast adopted after July
 1, 2002, as described above, results in an amount less than the amount
 appropriated herein, the lesser excess amount shall be prorated among
 those personnel eligible for the one-time salary supplements.
- 30Provided, further, that the funds appropriated herein shall be allocated31to local school systems and the state agencies listed herein and the32eligible nonpublic entities to implement the proposed salary33supplements.
- 34 Provided, however, that the one-time salary supplements shall in no way affect existing salary schedules, or benefit formulae for any 35 noncertificated school support personnel. 36 The one-time salary supplements shall be considered a one-time payment effective for 37 Fiscal Year 2002-2003 only. Any salary supplement payments made 38 in subsequent fiscal periods shall require additional appropriations. No 39 40 contributions to retirement systems shall be made concomitant with 41 these salary supplement payments, nor shall there be any effect on the 42 computation of future retirement benefits.
