Amendments proposed by Senator Hines to Reengrossed House Bill No. 1 by Representative LeBlanc

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On Page 274, after line 47, insert the following:

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18 Provided, however, that the one-time salary supplements shall be

19 implemented only in the event that the official Fiscal Year 2002-2003

20 Revenue Estimating Conference forecast adopted after July 1, 2002,

21 exceeds both the official Fiscal Year 2002-2003 Revenue Estimating

22 Conference forecast adopted on April 30, 2002, and any and all

23 revenues enacted into law as a result of the 2002 Regular Session of the

24 Louisiana Legislature.

25 Provided, further, that in the event that the official Fiscal Year

26 2002-2003 Revenue Estimating Conference forecast adopted after July

27 1, 2002, as described above, results in an amount less than the amount

28 appropriated herein, the lesser excess amount shall be prorated among

29 those personnel eligible for the one-time salary supplements.

30 Provided, further, that the funds appropriated herein shall be allocated

31 to local school systems and the state agencies listed herein and the

32 eligible nonpublic entities to implement the proposed salary

33 supplements.

34 Provided, however, that the one-time salary supplements shall in no

35 way affect existing salary schedules, or benefit formulae for any

36 noncertificated school support personnel. The one-time salary

37 supplements shall be considered a one-time payment effective for

38 Fiscal Year 2002-2003 only. Any salary supplement payments made

39 in subsequent fiscal periods shall require additional appropriations. No

40 contributions to retirement systems shall be made concomitant with

41 these salary supplement payments, nor shall there be any effect on the

42 computation of future retirement benefits. Provided that the

1 appropriation herein shall not be used to pay one-time salary
2 supplements for school personnel whose salaries are paid exclusively
3 from federal funds."
